RESIDENCY PROGRAM

- The UCSF OEM Residency Program was founded in 1979 and is fully accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME).
- The residency provides academic instruction, clinical and non-clinical experiences, and research opportunities.
- Our graduates are currently leaders in academia, government and nongovernmental organizations, clinical practice, and corporate settings.
- The program is housed within the Center for Occupational and Environmental Health (COEH), a multidisciplinary research and education partnership between UCSF, UC Berkeley, and UC Davis.

- Residents work with research faculty on projects ranging from respiratory health to ergonomics, climate change, and other topics.
- Clinical rotation sites include UCSF clinical sites, Kaiser, Agile, Concentra, and others.
- Public health rotation sites include the California Department of Public Health, the Bay Area Air District, the California Environmental Protection Agency, and Cal/OSHA.
- Administrative training sites include Zenith Insurance, Kaiser Administration, and rotations with corporate consultant preceptors.

- San Francisco Veterans Administration Hospital (SFVA) - Employee health, Veteran's environmental health evaluations, Compensation and Pension
- We also have a partnership with occupational health clinics at the Oracle Park, San Francisco International Airport and St. Francis Hospital
